Jesus said, “..I came that they may have life, and have it more abundantly – John 10:10 RSV



We call it our Power, Praise and Healing Service

Jesus came to preach, teach and heal. He also said His followers would do what he did and even more in His name.

The Church has done a good job preaching and teaching but many mainline denominations have forgotten the healing part. Healing is part of the total evangelistic obligation of the Church. Our weekly service will focus on healing of the body, mind and spirit in the overall context of worship and praise.

We do not want to replace doctors and the medical arts but, by faith, believe Jesus can heal the whole person. Often medicine and doctors miss the whole person. **Jesus will not.**

What is Christian Healing?

It is not “faith healing” although faith helps us to receive and accelerate healing. However, it is always God who heals and not our faith or the persons praying for healing.

Healing starts in the worship God and continues with the workings of the Holy Spirit in our midst. Offering a healing ministry is being obedient to what Jesus expects of His followers. He said, *“Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I go to the Father”.* (John 14.12).

Methods of administering healing prayers include the laying on of hands (LOH), praying over a person and anointing with oil. All are ways to minister healing as shown in the Bible, but there is no “right” technique or formula. Praying for healing acknowledges that

- God wants to heal and uses His Body, the Church, to carry out His will.
- God has the power to heal and will touch people through the power of His Holy Spirit
- Jesus never refused healing to anyone who asked for healing.

What to expect at the Power, Praise and Healing Service

We start with praise and worship as the Lord leads. It could be song, prayers, words of wisdom, prophesy, readings or tongues. Gifts of the Holy Spirit are present.

The focus is to worship and glorify God. That sets the stage for the Holy Spirit to do great things in our midst. Jesus promised when two or more gather in His name, He will be there also.

Jesus will show up!

“And Jesus called the twelve together and gave them power and authority over all demons and to cure disease, and he sent them out to preach the kingdom of God and to heal. (Luke 9.1-2)

“After that the Lord appointed seventy others and them ahead of him in every town and place where he himself as about to come. And he said to them, “The harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few....heal the sick and say to them, “The Kingdom of God has come near.” (Luke 10.1,2 & 9)
